To determine the utility of maternal alcohol history taking in the context of maternal mental health problems and chronic alcohol use among women admitted to inpatient treatment for a perceived parenting or maternal problem. The authors reviewed the medical records of all women admitted to an inpatient treatment program in Indiana between April 1997 and May 2004, who had two or more visits to a community-based perinatal home visiting program after the initial admission. The authors included two groups of women: (1) those who were admitted to treatment for chronic alcohol use and a "perceived parenting problem" and (2) those who were admitted for problems in maternal mental health and chronic alcohol use. The authors used medical records to determine whether the women had a positive or negative maternal alcohol history and whether they had an abnormal birth outcome. Of the 1,409 women in the sample, 71 had a positive maternal alcohol history and 46 were admitted for a maternal mental health problem and chronic alcohol use. There was no difference in the number of women in the alcohol and non-alcohol groups who had an abnormal birth outcome. Among women admitted for problems in maternal mental health and chronic alcohol use, a positive maternal alcohol history was significantly associated with an abnormal birth outcome (odds ratio: 3.51; 95% CI: 1.47-8.42). If there is a history of maternal alcohol use, physicians who see pregnant women in an inpatient setting need to inquire about the use of alcohol, even if the woman reports no problems.
